Sorting guide



Residual waste

Litter, diapers, pads, envelopes, tampons, cotton buds, dish brushes, toothbrushes, broken china, cigarette butts and snuff, vacuum cleaner bags, dish cloths, disposable razors, sponges, wine corks, pens, candles and CDs.



Food waste

Fruit and potato peel, avocado
peel and core, onion peel, eggshells,
coffee filters, tea bags, fishbones and
seafood shells, bones of meat.



Paper packaging

Corrugated cardboard, cartons from pasta, cereal and milk, paper cups, toilet rolls, household paper rolls, egg cartons, shoe boxes, padded envelopes och paper bags.






Metal packaging

Cans, bottle caps, metal lids, metal tubes and bag sealer - with metal wire on e.g. bread bags.




Plastic packaging

Soft and hard plastic, styrofoam, bubble wrap, medicine trays, bottles, plastic lids, plastic cans, fruit nets, plastic tubes, bag-in-box bags, refills and soap bottles and deodorant.



Newspapers/paper

Newspapers, magazines, leaflets, brochures, catalogues, writing and drawing paper and paperbacks.



Coloured glass packaging

Coloured glass bottles and glass jars.



Clear glass packaging


Clear glass bottles and glass jars.

Never put drinking glasses, vases, mirror glass, glass plates or china together with glass packaging.



Textiles

Clothes, accessories, shoes, sheets, table cloths, curtains, towels - dry and clean.



Bulky waste

Bikes, furniture, mattresses, carpets, scrap metal, wood waste, mirrors, pots and ceramics.



Light bulbs

Low energy lamps, LED-lamps, halogen lamps and light bulbs.



Small electronics

Electric toothbrush, shaver, mobile phones, remote control, charger, headphones, small battery-powered toys and computer mouse.



Second hand items

Functional stuff.



Garden waste

Leaves, windfalls, grass, twigs, branches and hedge clippings.



Small batteries

Rod batteries, square batteries and button cell batteries.



Hazardous waste

Spray cans, nail polish, solvents, paint and varnish residues.

Where do I go?



Recycling centre, "Återvinningscentralen"

Old furniture, second hand items, boards and building materials, cardboard boxes, garden waste, hazardous waste and electronics such as mobile phones, screens and computers can be brought to the staffed recycling centers.

You are responsible for sorting each type of waste into their correct containers. The staff is there to help you make sure all the recyclable materials are properly sorted.

There are two recycling centres close to Malmö and Burlöv:

Norra hamnens återvinningscentral, Bjurögatan 20b, Malmö

Bunkeflo återvinningscentral, Gottorpsvägen 52, Malmö

Recycling station, "Återvinningsstation"

There are approximately 60 recycling stations in Malmö and Burlöv. The stations are for recycling of household packaging and paper, if there are not any possibilities to do so at your home. Waste that is not packaging or paper must be taken to a recycling center.

Pop-up Returnen

Pop-up Returnen is a touring reuse and recycling station that stops at various locations in Malmö and Burlöv. The service turns to private individuals who are given the opportunity to recycle bulky waste, electrical waste and hazardous waste as well as dropping off and picking up items for reuse. The Hazardous Waste truck, "Farligt avfall-bilen"

The Hazardous Waste truck makes two trips a year in Malmö, one in the spring and one in the fall. Here you leave leftover paint, chemicals, light bulbs, spray bottles, batteries and solvents. You can also leave small-electronics up to the size of a microwave oven. Tour list with times, dates and stops can be found at sysav.se/farligtavfallbilen

Samlaren - collection in stores

Small electronic devices, small batteries, light bulbs and low energy lamps can be deposited in "samlaren". "Samlaren" is a safety cabinet placed in several grocery stores around Malmö and Burlöv. Find your closest "Samlaren" at vasyd.se/samlaren
